

Why was my car booted?

Any vehicle with three or more unpaid parking tickets aged over 30 days is placed on a list referred to as the *scoff list* or *boot list*.

This list is reviewed by parking enforcement staff and when a vehicle on the list is encountered, a wheel locking device, or “boot”, is attached to the car.



When will the boot be removed?

When **all** outstanding fines and the \$100 administrative fee are paid within 48 hours, the boot will be removed. (Per City Code 60-9) The cashier will inform enforcement staff.

Where can I pay?

- 1) In person at City Hall, 1 E. Franklin St. from 8:00am-4:30pm by cash, check, money order, or credit card.
- 2) By calling 301-797-6210 from 8:00am-4:30pm with a credit card.
- 3) After-hours and on weekends at the police station on Burhans Blvd.

What happens if I cannot pay?

48 hours after the boot has been placed on the vehicle, the car will be towed. In place of the \$100 boot administrative fee, towing and storage fees will be added.
