


Arts & Entertainment District to City Park Trail City of Hagerstown

1A	Construct path up to and through City-owned 43-53 W Washington St to connect to existing Market Walk
1B	Alternate Route - Install crosswalk behind Maryland Theatre and utilize brick sidewalk on west side of street
2A	Possible spur through privately-owned courtyard at 17 W Washington St
2B	Alternate Route - Install gateway art and improve Rochester Alley to be more pedestrian friendly
3A	W Antietam Street - minor streetscape work, walkway on north side and possible mid-block crosswalk
3B	Spur to connect trail directly to S Potomac Street destinations
4	10 foot paved trail with lights through Herald-Mail property
5	Possible parklet area with art, features TBD
6	Reconstruct Hood Street/W Baltimore Street intersection for pedestrian and bicycle safety
7	10 foot paved trail with lights through Housing Authority property
8	10 foot paved trail with lights through Ellsworth property - Include landscaping and bollards as needed
9	W Lee Street - minor streetscape work and possible mid block crosswalk
10	Convert Hood Street to one way northbound. Street remains on east side of right-of-way while trail is on the west side
11	Narrow Sycamore Street to south side of right-of-way and install trail on the north side
12	Widen sidewalk on east side of Summit Avenue. Widen CSX rail crossing. Connect to existing multi-use path
