EXECUTIVE SESSION – July 30, 2013

Metzner made a motion to meet in closed session to consider the acquisition of real property for a public purpose and matters directly related thereto, #3 (Section 10-508(a)), and to discuss public security, if the public body determines that public discussions would constitute a risk to the public or public security, including: (1) the deployment of fire and police services and staff; and (ii) the development and implementation of emergency plans, #10 (Section 10-508(a)) at 4:02 p.m. in the Mayor's Office, 2nd Floor, City Hall, Hagerstown, Maryland. Councilmember D. F. Munson seconded the motion.

Councilmember Aleshire stated he thinks the first item should be discussed in open session.

Motion carried with Councilmember K. B. Aleshire voting No.
