Neighborhood Services



Untagged vehicles

All vehicles (cars, trucks, trailers, etc.) stored on the exterior of a structure are to be operable and currently licensed.

Covering the car with a car cover or tarp is not in compliance.

Safety Tip

An abandoned vehicle on a property creates blight and can invite criminal activity to a home.



PLANNING

Land Management Code on Semi-Trailers

The Land Management Code also states vehicles are to be properly licensed along with semi-trailers. Semi-trailers are to be only on a property to transport goods and not for storage.



PERMITS

Permit is required to build a garage

Unlicensed or dismantled vehicles can be stored in an enclosed garage.

A building permit is to be obtained to add a garage on your property.
