Vendor and Peddler Permits

The Planning and Code Administration Department works closely with the City Clerk to ensure businesses are obtaining vendor or peddler permits. Inspectors meet with businesses and explain the process to become a properly licensed vendor or peddler in the City.

Planning

Although there are no restrictions for vendors and peddlers per the Land Management Code, the Zoning Administrator reviews the locations vendors and peddlers want to operate to make sure these types of businesses are consistent with the uses in the area.



Permits

Vendors and peddlers that have been successful with their business sometimes choose to open a “brick and mortar” store. These businesses will then obtain permits to meet the currently adopted building and trade codes through our department.



Did You Know?

Vendor and peddler permits are renewed annually.
