what requires a permit?

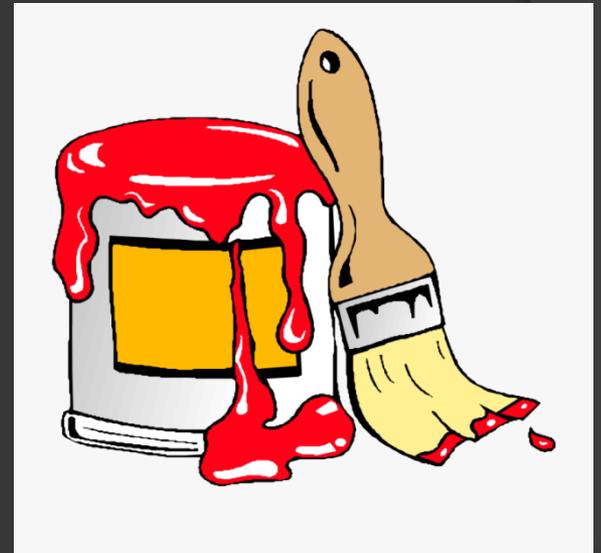
Before you start work

- Each property is unique
- Each situation is different
- Talk with a City inspector
- Not every situation requires a permit but every situation should be discussed with the City inspector
- Residential units only
- Previous history



Building Work

- Who can obtain a building permit?
- Adding a closet?
- Adding a wall?
- Adding a room
(bedroom/bathroom/den/etc.)?
- New carpet, paint, tiling, flooring, or
cabinetry?



Building Work

- Replacing stair treads?
- Replacing a stair stringer?
- Replacing what was there?
- Replacing decking?
- Replacing porch posts?
- Replacing handrails or guardrails?



Plumbing Work

- Who can obtain plumbing permits?
- Replacing a fixture (toilet, sink, kitchen sink)?
- Replacing supply and drain lines?
- Replacing a trap?
- Replacing valves?



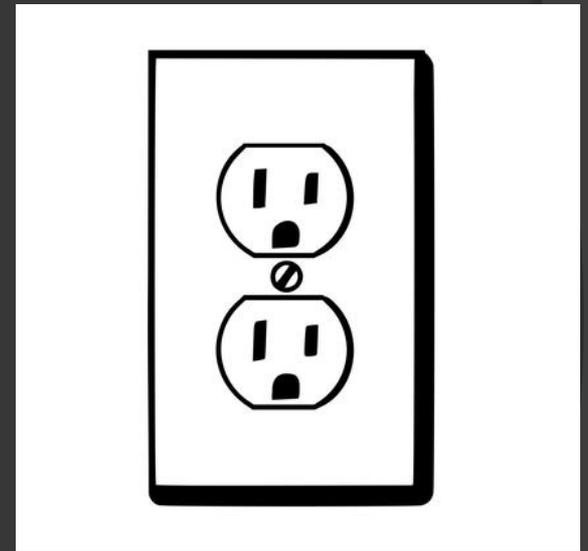
Plumbing Work

- Replacing a water heater?
- Replacing or adding an expansion tank?
- Adding a refrigerator with an ice maker?
- Adding a gas line for a furnace, stove, or water heater?
- Removing an oil tank?



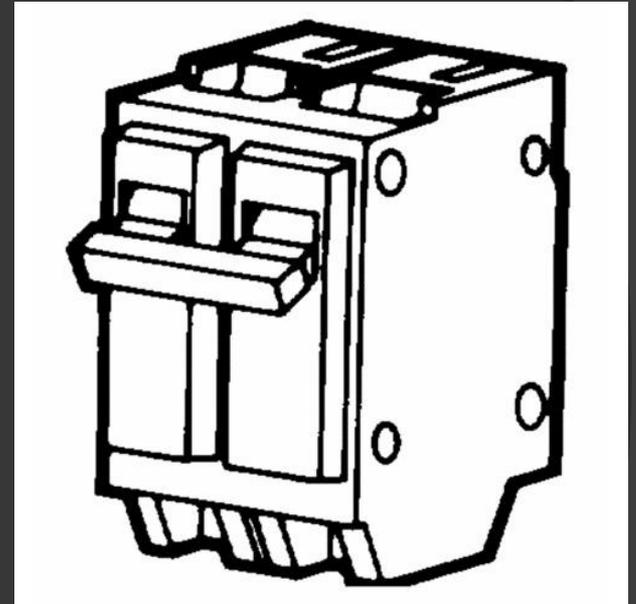
Electrical Work

- Who can obtain electrical permits?
- Is knob and tube wiring allowed?
- Replacing existing outlets/receptacles?
- Changing an existing outlet/receptacle to a GFCI?
- Adding an outlet/receptacle?



Electrical Work

- Grounding an outlet/receptacle?
- Adding a countertop outlet/receptacle?
- Replacing a breaker?
- Adding a junction box?



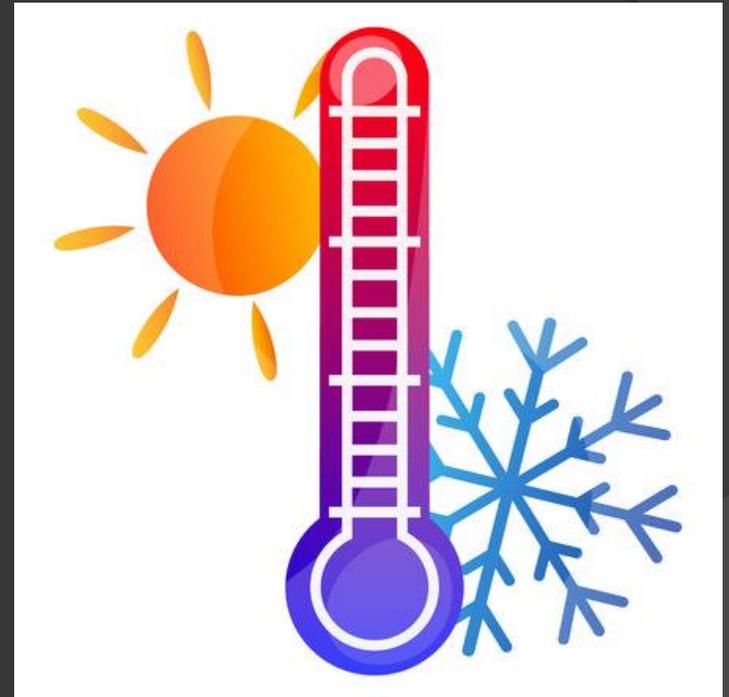
Electrical Work

- Outlet over an electric baseboard heater?
- Hardwired smoke alarm needs moved?
- Need an emergency cut-off switch?



Mechanical Work

- Who can obtain mechanical permits?
- Replacing an HVAC system, a push/pull replacement?
- Replacing an existing exhaust fan?
- Replacing an existing kitchen hood?
(Residential)
- Changing venting?
